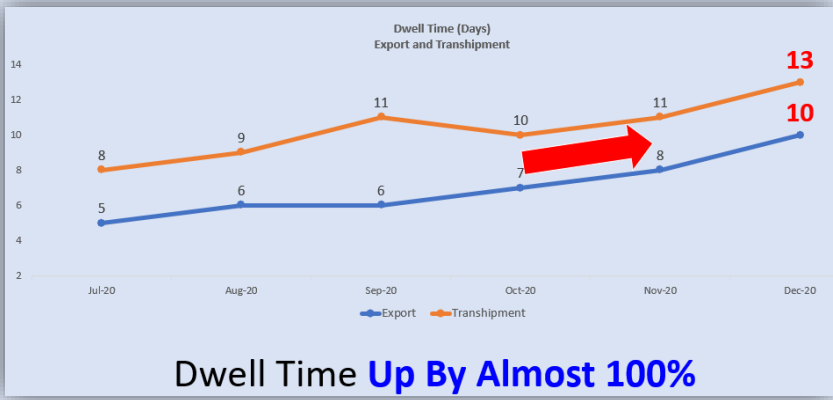
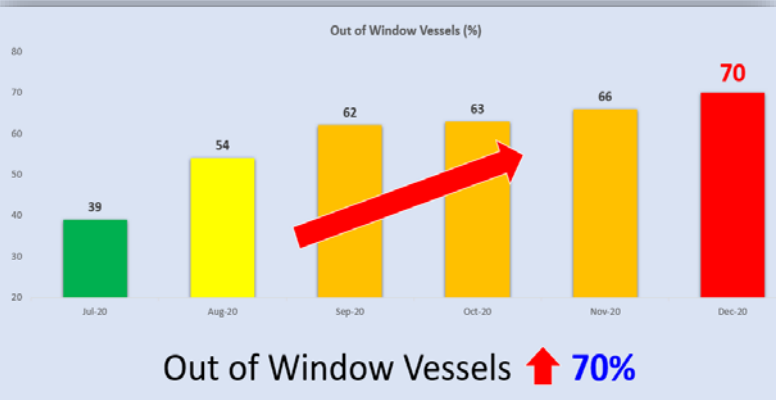


COVID-19 PANDEMIC IMPACT TO WESTPORTS BUSINESS

Quarterly Container Volume 2020 vs 2019



- Westports handled a slightly lower container throughput of 10.5 million TEUs (2019: 10.8 million).
- A reduction of 3% in 2020 vs 2019.
- Demand was affected by the various forms of lockdown across the world to control the transmission COVID-19.

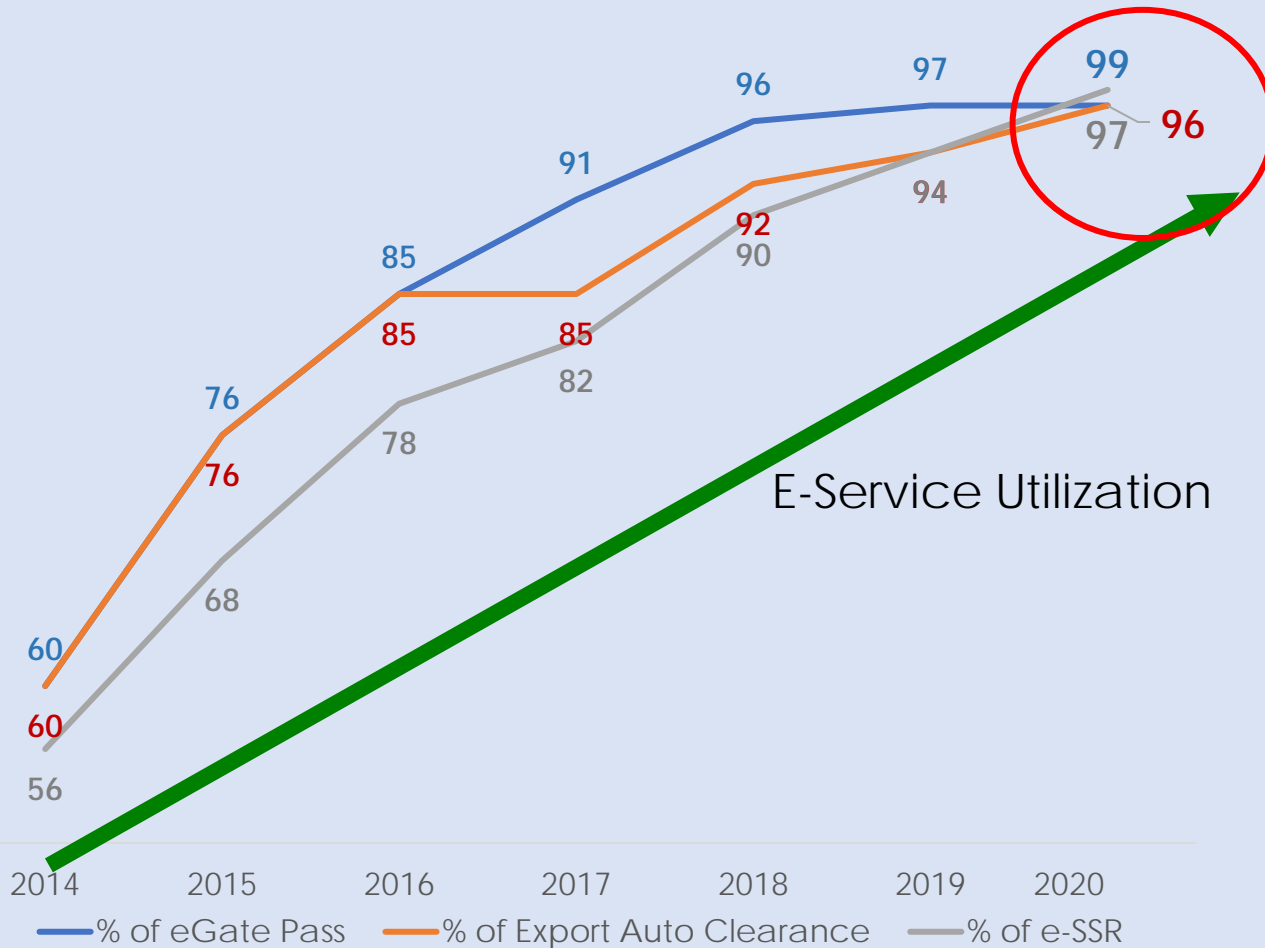

E-service utilization as at Dec 2020
reached an average of 98%



Electronically-generated by forwarding agents through the e-Terminal Plus portal



Issued instantly without the need to collect it from the port



Free of charge



Forwarding agents are able to collect import containers more quickly
