

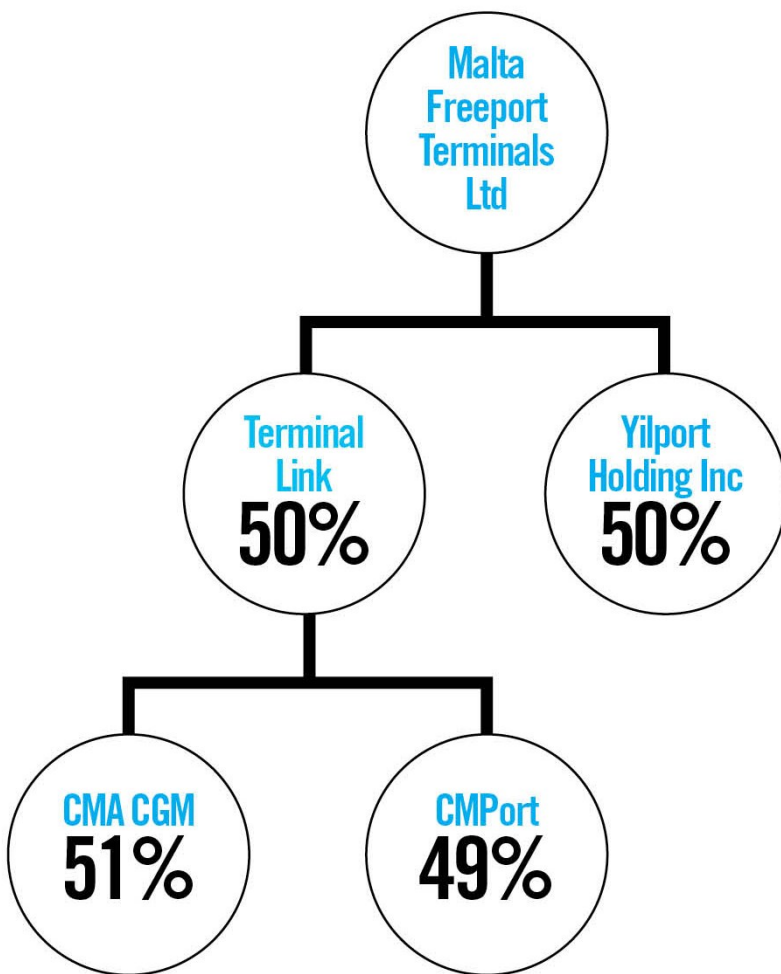

Strategically located at the crossroads of the world's greatest maritime routes

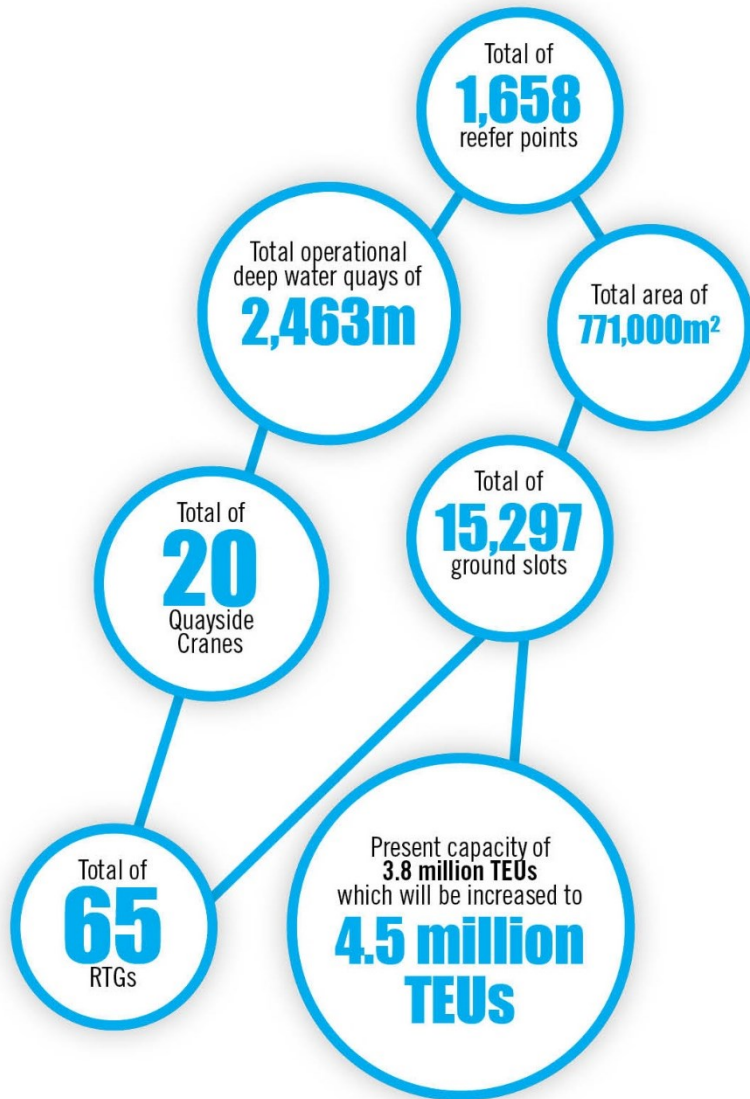
Provides a minimal diversion distance of just **6 nautical miles** between Gibraltar and the entrance to the Suez Canal

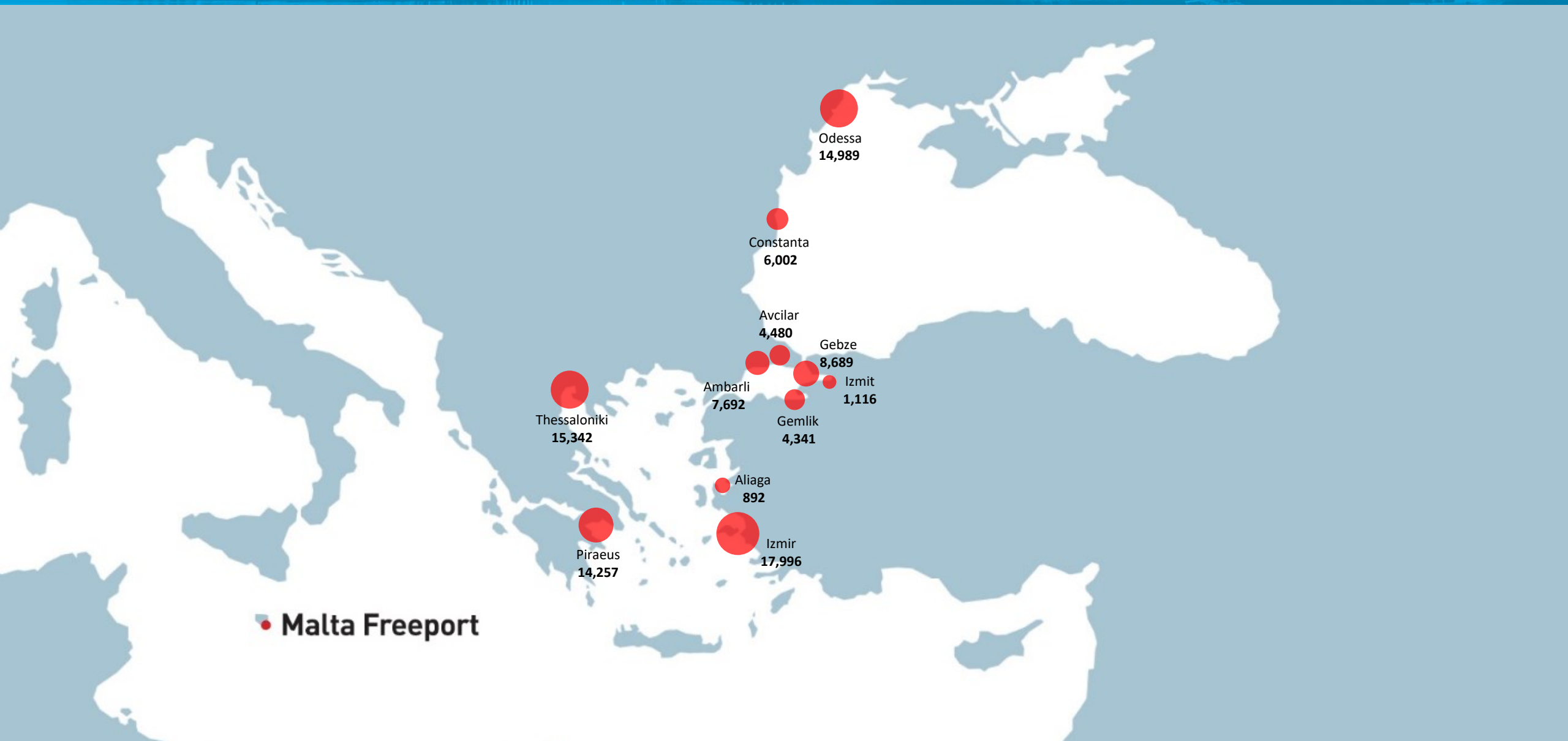
