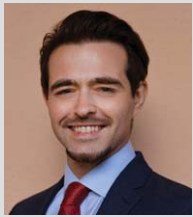

**Ilya Milimukha**

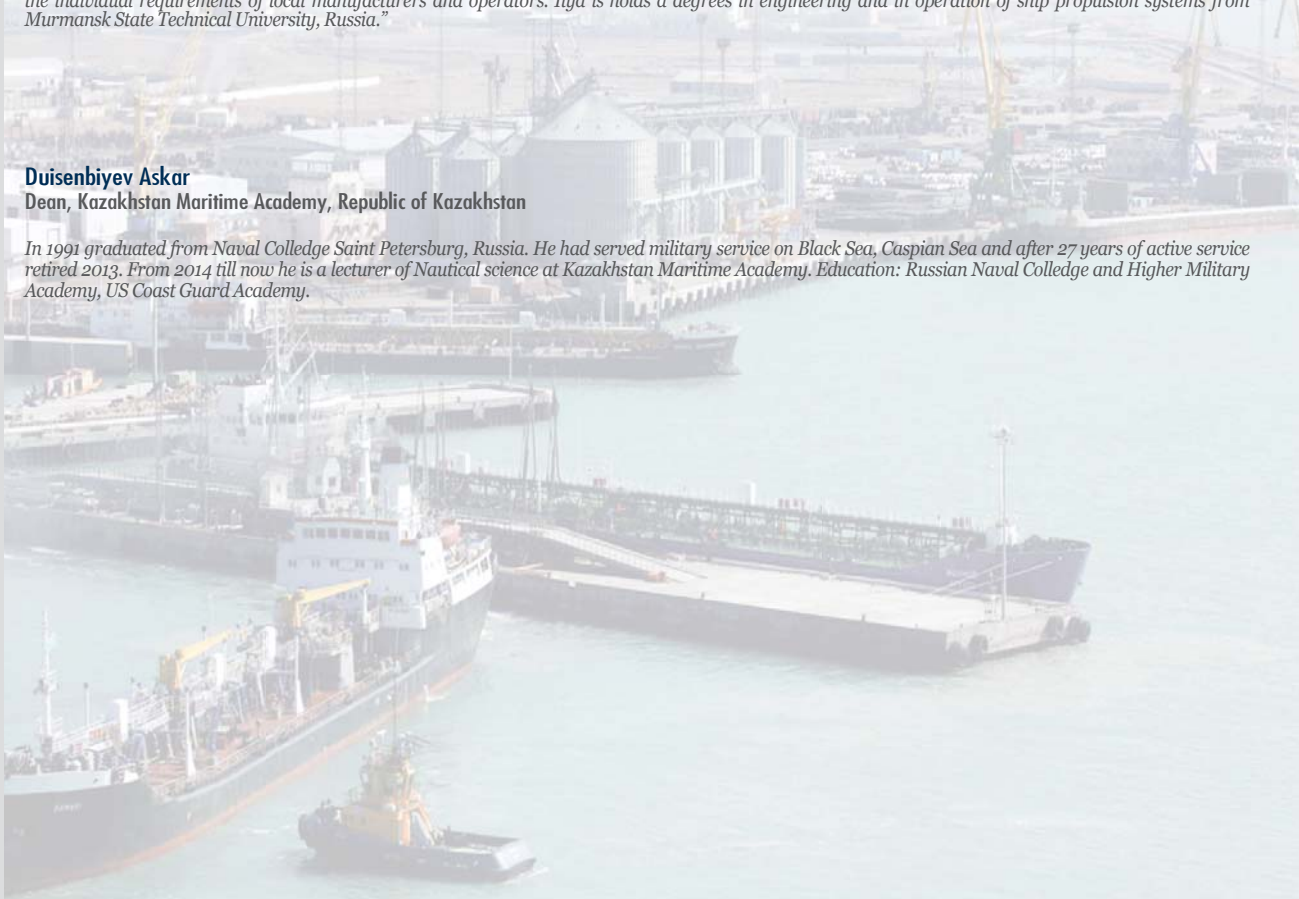
Business Development Manager, Power Collection, Stemmman-Technik, Russia

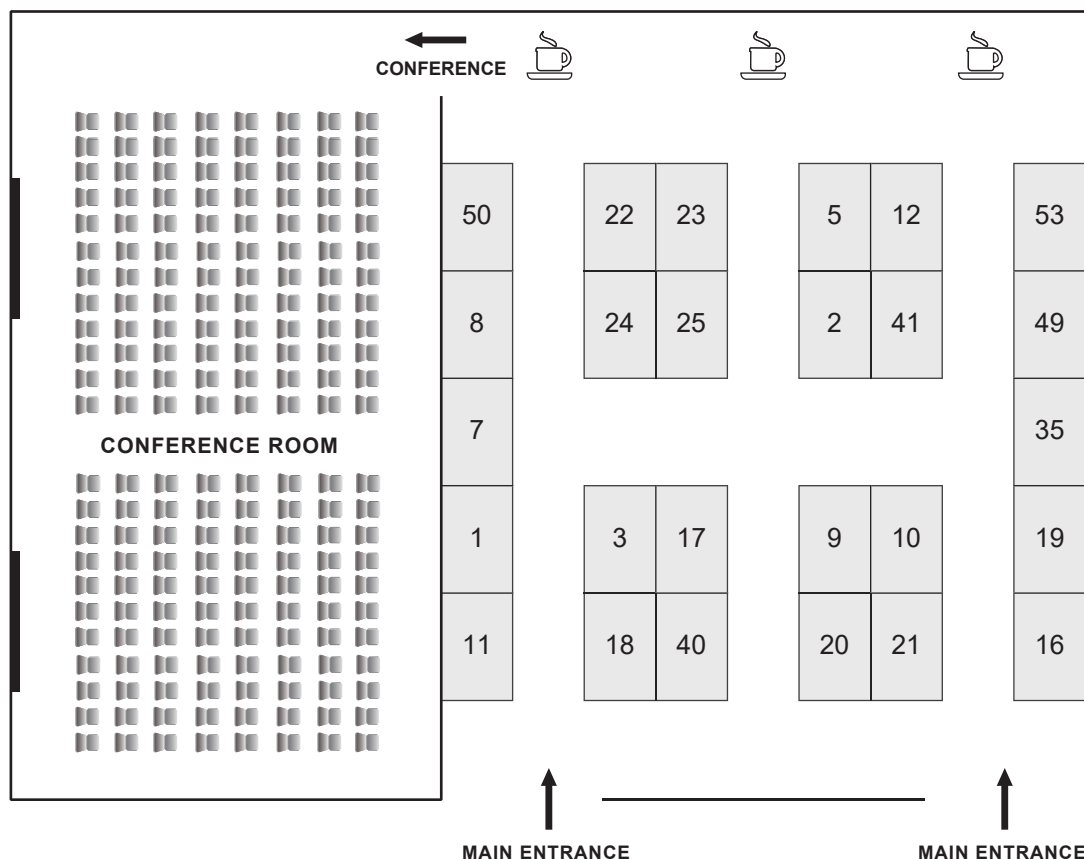
