- Poland's largest seaport – Poland is the 7<sup>th</sup> economy in Europe and 22<sup>nd</sup> in the World
- In 2020 Port of Gdańsk handled 48 million tonnes
- 46% share in the Polish ports' cargo throughput
- Ranked 4<sup>th</sup> among the largest ports on the Baltic Sea
- Ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Baltic Sea in terms of the number of containers handled
- All cargo port, including containers, automotive, liquid fuel, dry bulk, chemicals


