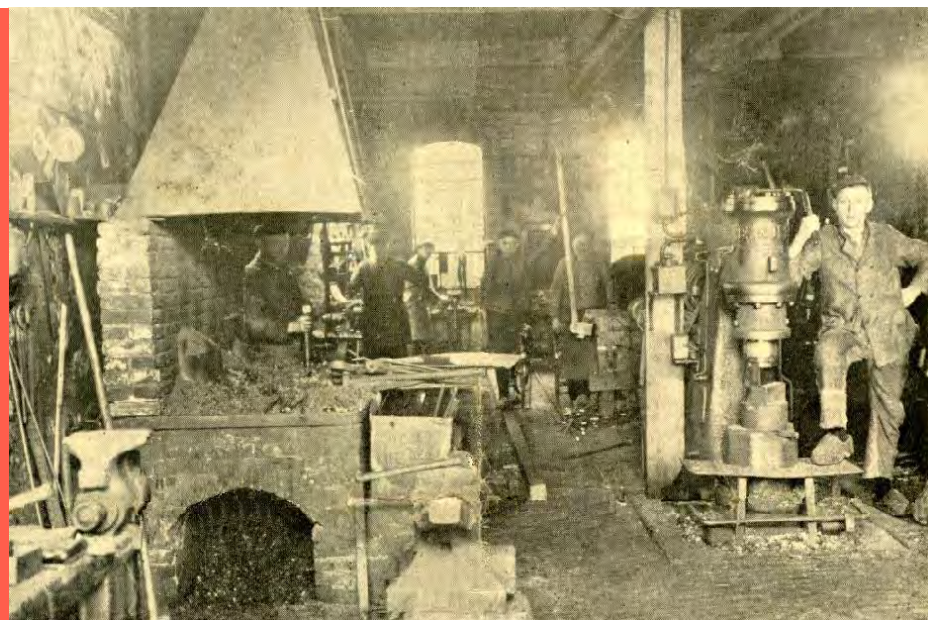

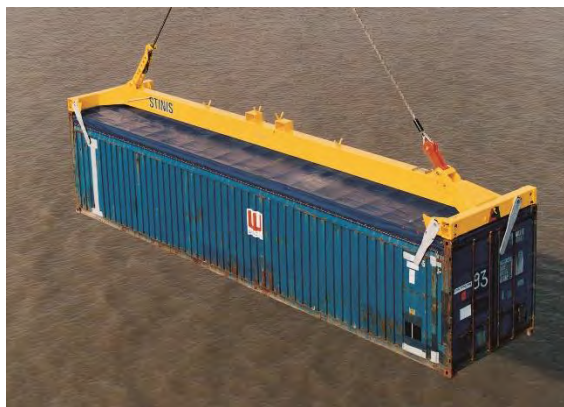
1967 FIRST CONTAINER SPREADER

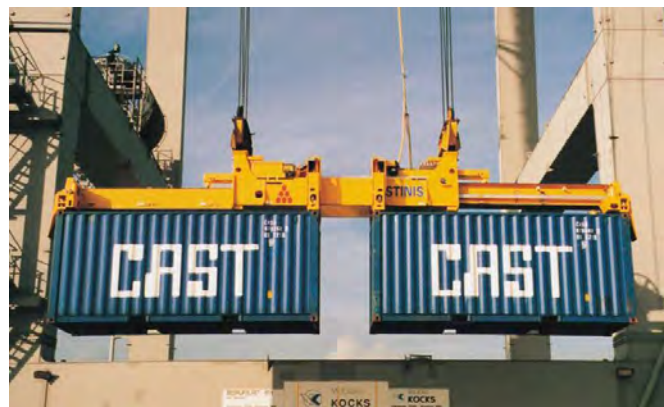

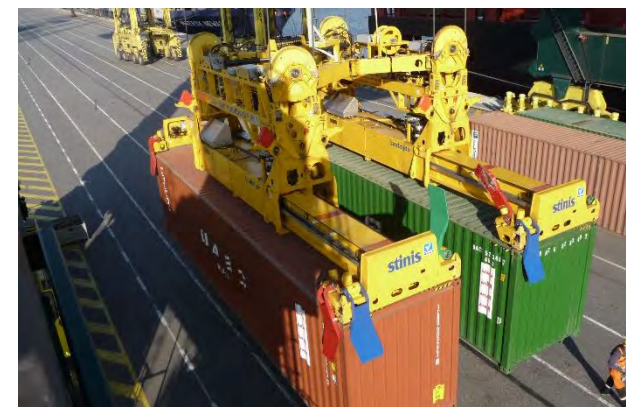
1989 STINIS AUTOTWIST®

Stinis designed and produced the first Long-Twin® spreader in the world, reshaping the spreader industry.

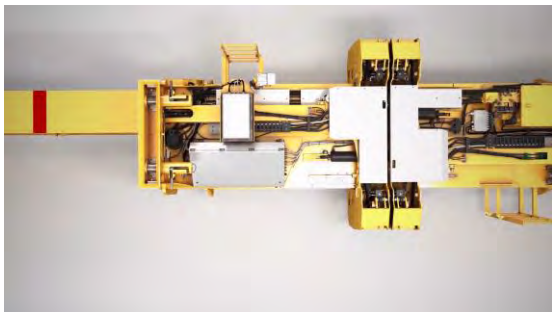


2005 STINIS SPLIT-HEADBLOCK®

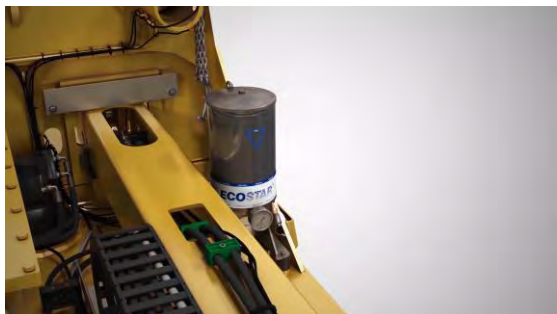

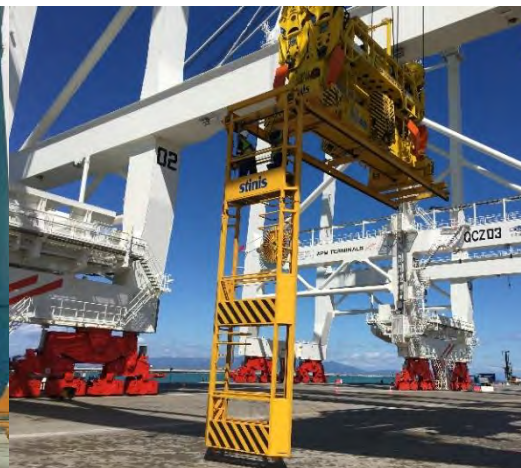
