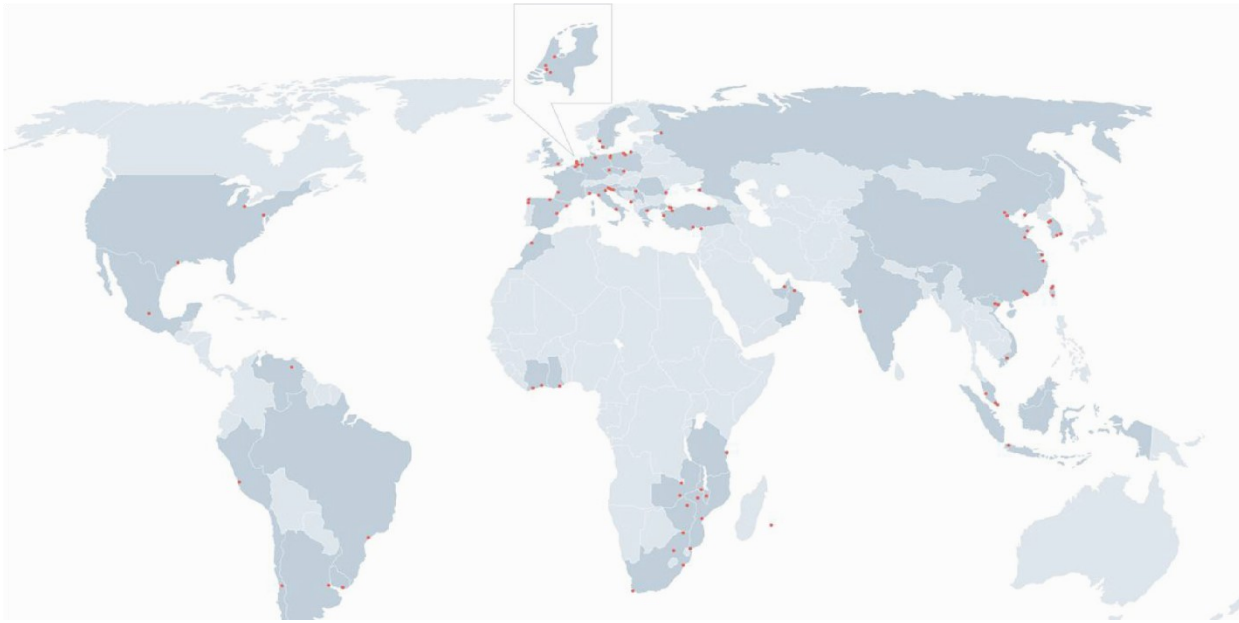

- Heavy vehicle



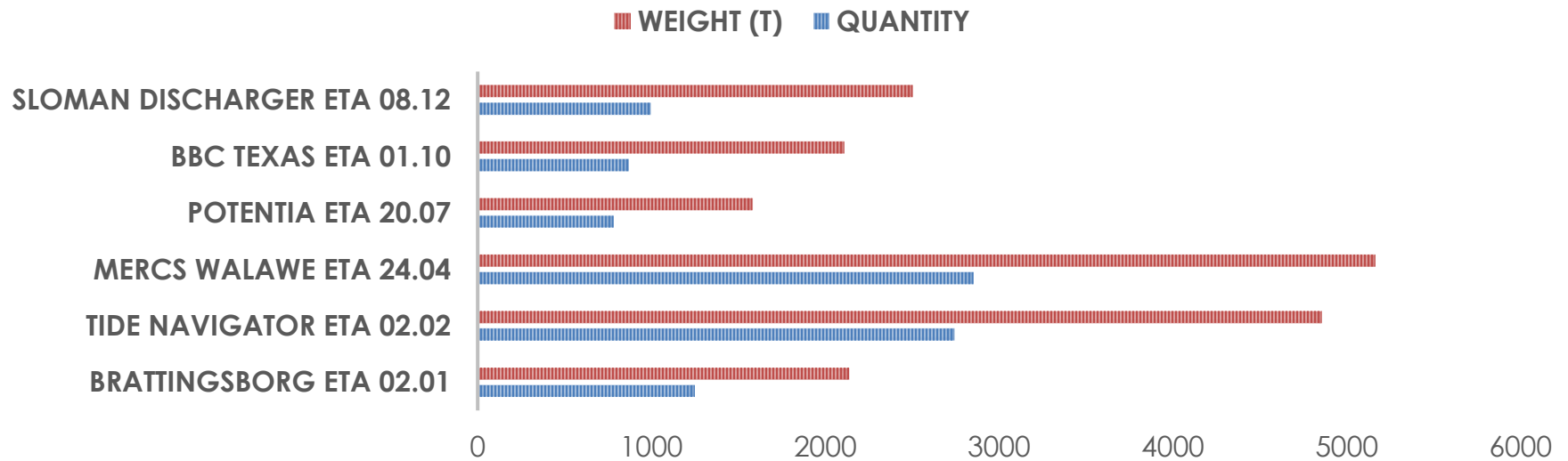


Project Cargo at Reunion Island (2004 – 2019)

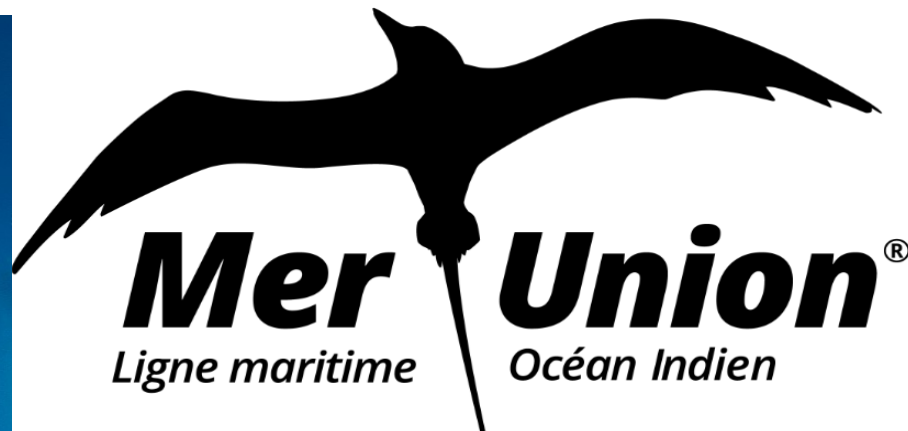


PORT REUNION : MER UNION 2020



Safety, security & quality

- Strictly neutral and independent service provider : RSM (shipping agent) and LA COR (stevedore)
- Safe working conditions are controlled according to the French Health and Safety Act.
- The vessel Potentia arrived outside the Port on 17 July : 18 crew members were tested by medical staff before docking. The results were obtained within 24 hours : all COVID19 tests were negative.
