

The shipping line Mer Union specialises in the transport of general cargo from Europe to the Indian Ocean.

Mer Union offers a breakbulk service from the Port of Antwerp to the Comoros Island, Mayotte, Madagascar and Reunion Island.

Mer Union offers a regular - breakbulk - sailing from the Port of Antwerp to Reunion Island every 2 months with a transit time of approximately 35 days.



Safety, security & quality

- Strictly neutral and independent service provider: RSM (shipping agent) and LA COR (stevedore)
- Safe working conditions are controlled according to the French Health and Safety Act.
- The vessel Potentia arrived outside the Port on 17 July: 18 crew members were tested by medical staff before docking. The results were obtained within 24 hours: all COVID19 tests were negative.
