






FUTURES DEVELOPMENTS FOR THE EAST PORT





Streamlining current facilities:

1. Bonded wharehouses (4000 m2) & stacking yards (containter: 18 ha, Roro, breakbulk and project cargo: 8 ha)

Short term developments:

2. Strenghtening of East Port container facilities:

reefer terminal upgrade (360 to 500 plugs)

4+2 new STS able to reach across 20 rows

1+1 mobile harbour crane able to rach across 14 rows

3. Shift from coal to biomass for energy imports: construction of a biomass silo (storage capacity: 160 000 m3)

Middle term developments:

- 4. Relocation of the oil terminal
- **5. Development of the New Support Services area:** dedicated to industry and logistics (85 Ha, with 45 Ha for port activities)

Long term developments:

5. Container terminal extension reclaimed from the sea






