Port Gdynia Today



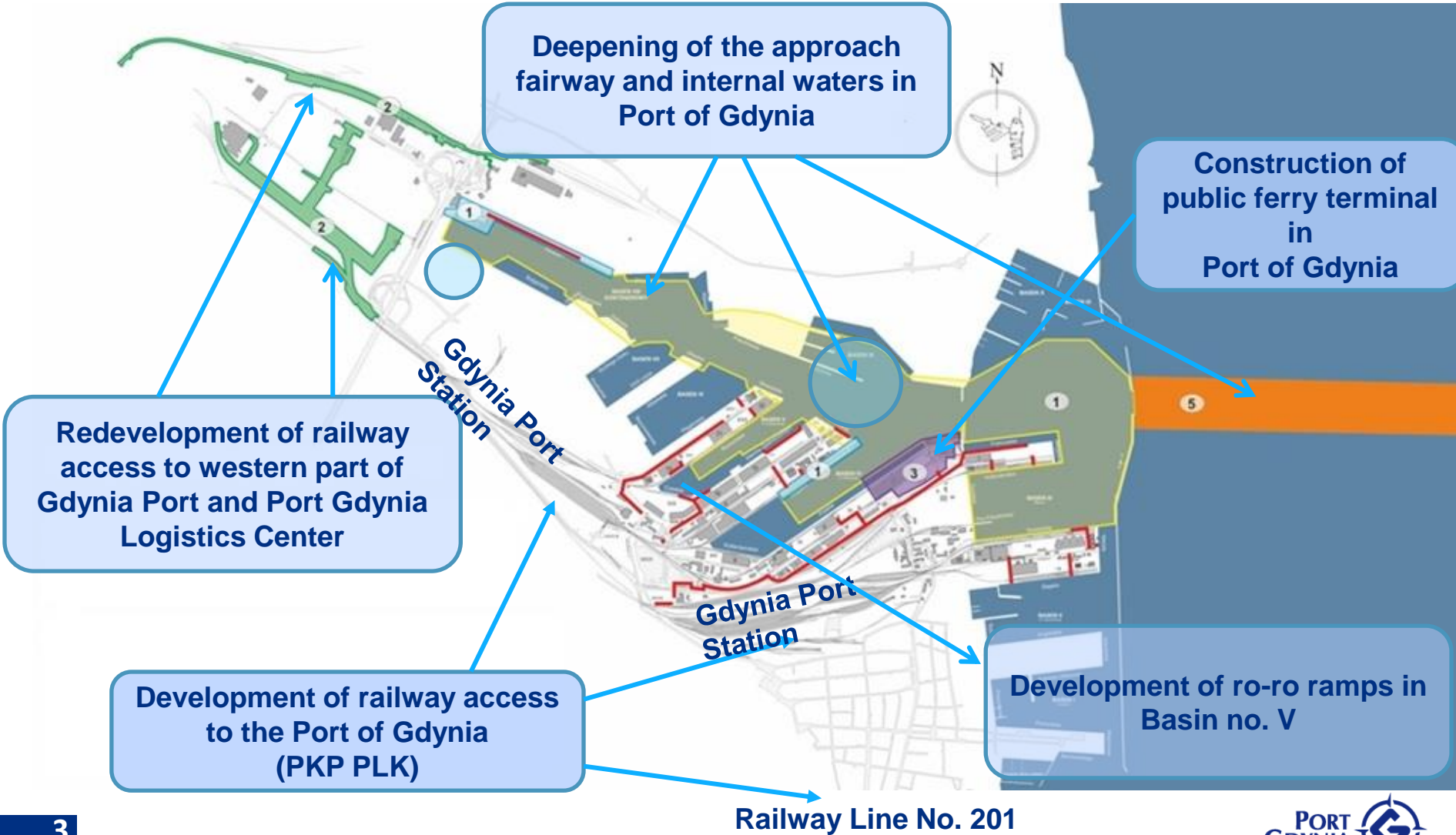
The **Port of Gdynia** is a universal modern port with a great geographic location. It specializes in handling general cargo, mainly unitized cargo transported in containers and in a ro-ro system. Ports' activities base on well-developed network of regular container, ro-ro and ferry connections, including Short Seas Shipping services. An important role in the port's activity is played by well-equipped bulk terminals.

Basic navigational and technical data:

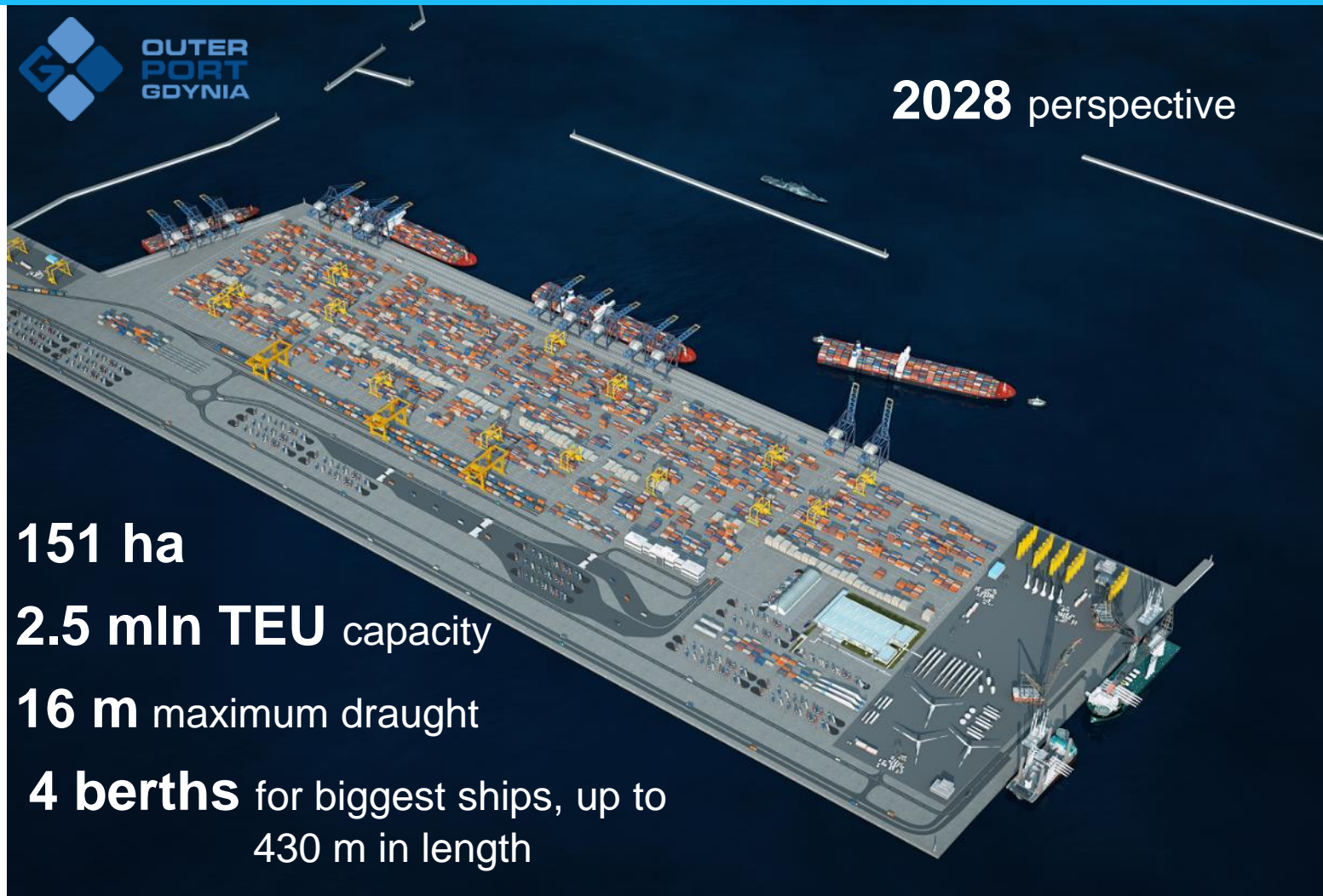
- maritime entrance to the port: **150 m wide with a depth of 14.0 m**,
- total port area: 973.1 ha, including 621.5 ha land area (**274.0 ha managed by PGA S.A.**),
- total length of quays: 11.7 km,
- max. draught along **the quays: 13.0 m**.
