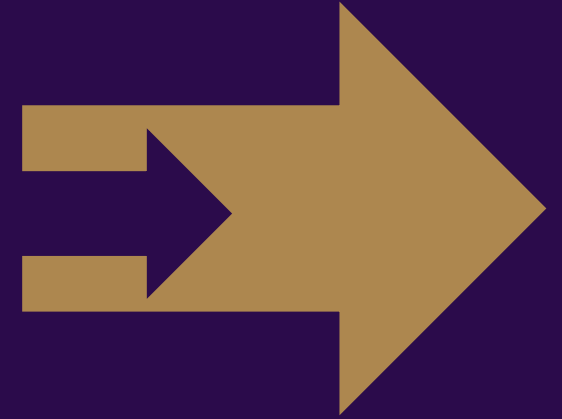

We are CILT

We are the leading **professional body** for **everyone** who works in supply chain, logistics and transport.

We are a **global family**, representing **professionals** at all levels across all sectors, with a mission to give individuals and organizations access to the tools, knowledge and the connections vital to success in the logistics and transport industry.





History

- At the Savoy Hotel in London on 3 November 1919 a group of senior transport professionals met determined to change the world of logistics and transport.
- In the First World War they had seen the failures of moving goods and vehicles. Now in peacetime they wanted to create a professional body that would make a difference and set new standards. The Institute of Transport was born.
- In 1926 we were granted a Royal Charter by King George V with himself as the Patron and the Prince of Wales as the Honorary President.
- The Institute grew in importance and influence across the world. We established territorial organisations in ten countries and in 1971 were granted the name of the Chartered Institute of Transport by Queen Elizabeth II.
- In 2001 we became the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport as the two leading professional bodies joined together.

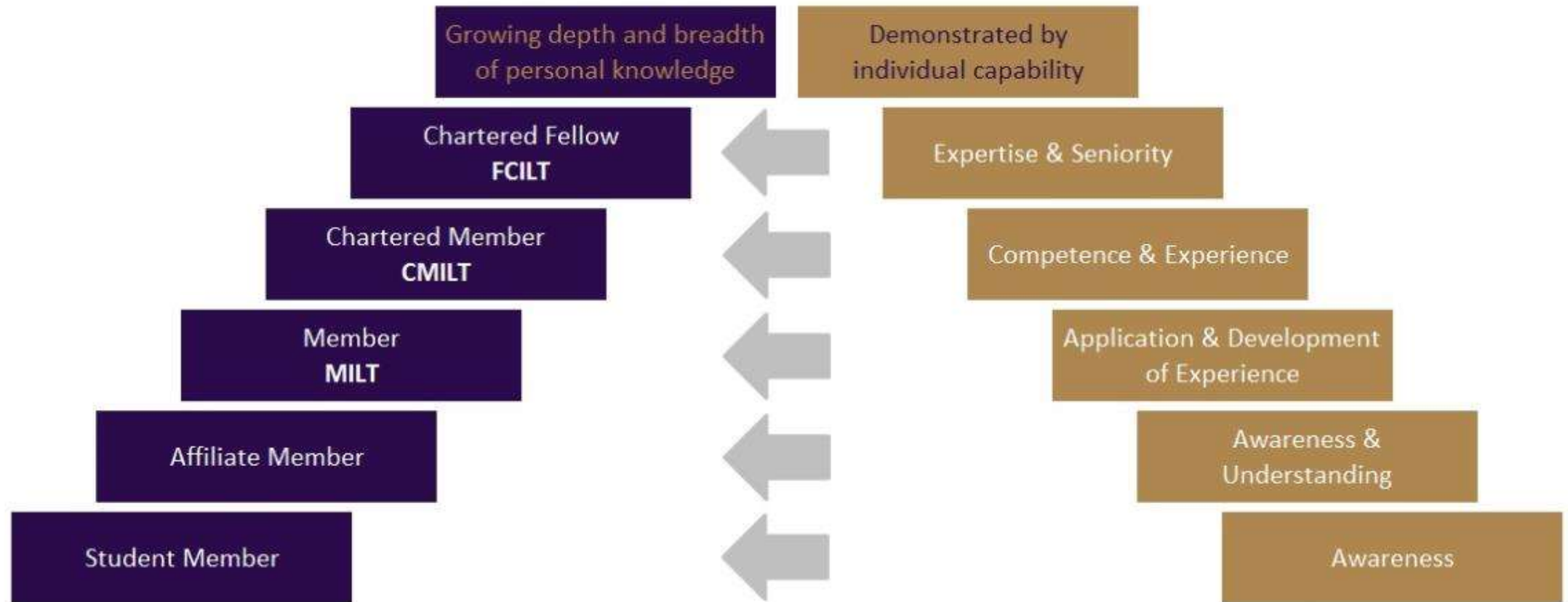

CILT Qualifications Pathway

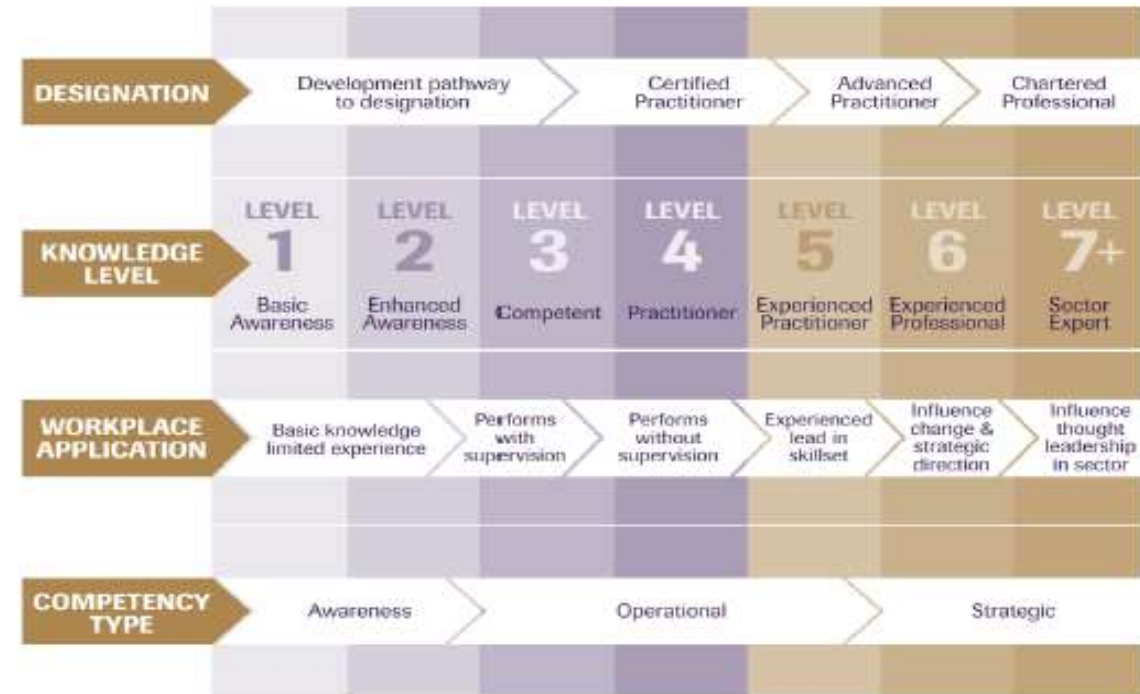




CILT Qualifications Pathway

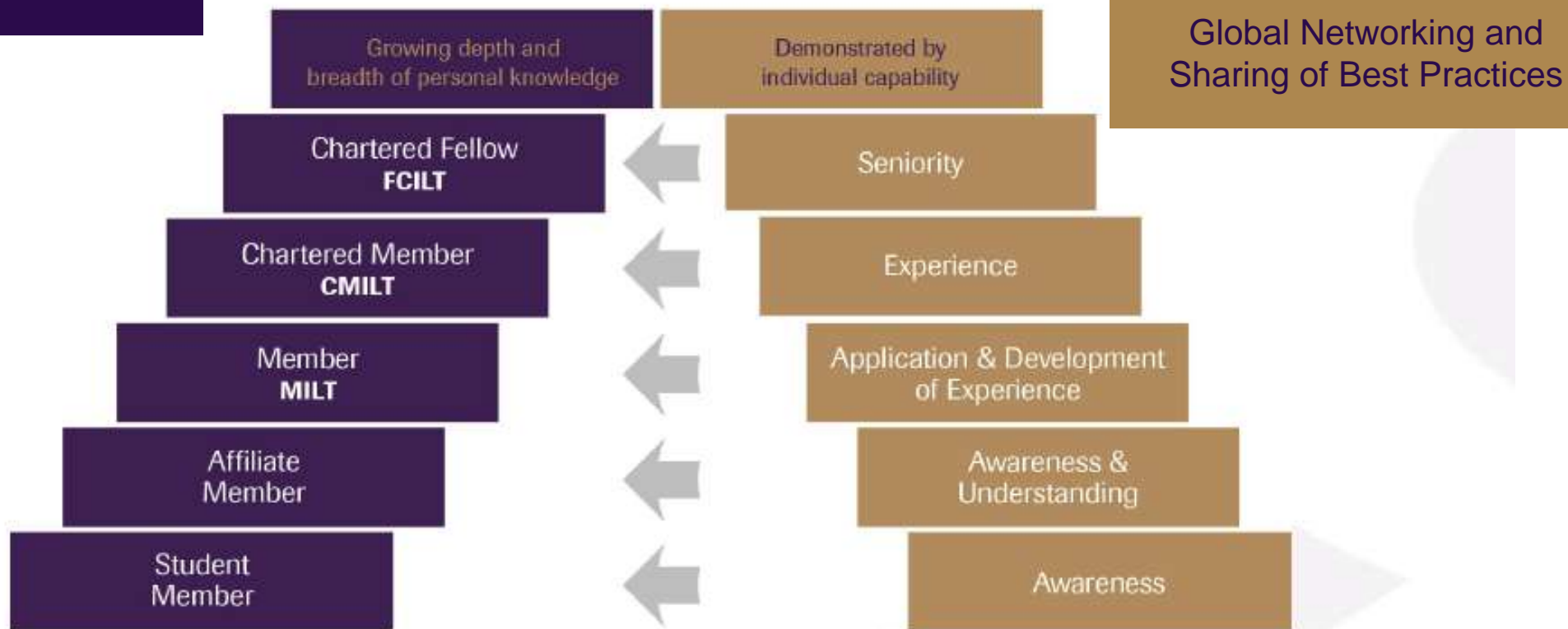




CILT Qualifications Pathway

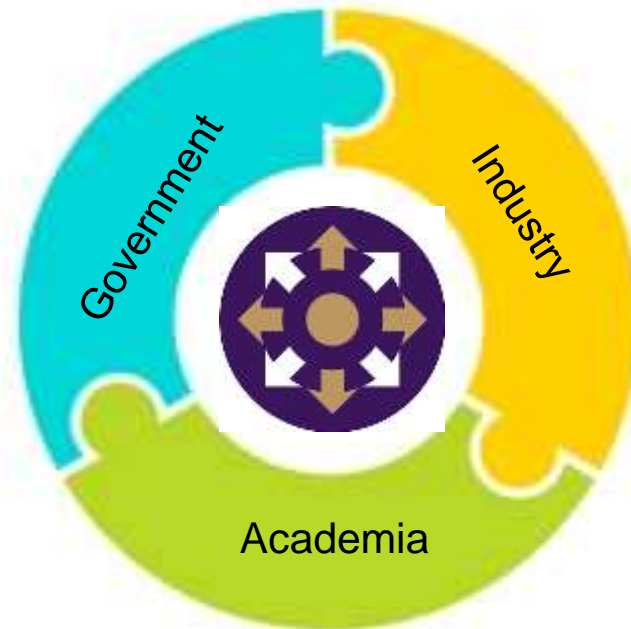

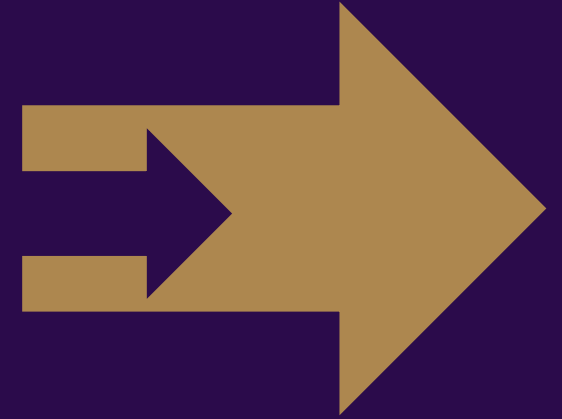
