



- Gazetted as an INTEGRATED FREE ZONE in June 2004 for Industrial & Commercial activities.
- Free Industrial Zone (FIZ) & Free Commercial Zone (FCZ)
- Launched on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2004.

## INDUSTRIAL ZONE

LAND



- 628 acres of open land for long term leases
- 100% leased

LIU



- 512 units of Light Industrial Unit (LIU)
- 1 unit built-up area is 5,487 sq. ft.
- For light manufacturing, trading, warehousing & logistics activities.
- 60% occupancy, 40% available





- ✓ Development of new container yard to increase capacity by 560,000 TEUs

## • LPG Storage & Distribution Hub

- ✓ Dedicated berth at LBTS to cater both LPG & LNG ships

## • Westports Expansion


- ✓ To add 4.8km berth
- ✓ Additional handling capacity 14 million TEUs
- ✓ Undertaken in 2 phases over a period of 20 years
- ✓ **CT10 to be completed by end Q2 2028**

- ✓ Natural deep water of 20-metre
- ✓ Basin design for land optimization
