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


Oriental Port and Allied Services Corporation (OPASCOR)

Since its establishment in 1990, OPASCOR has developed expertise in cargo handling and other allied port services through more than 30 years of experience.



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
Its incorporation paved the way to the birth of a workers' enterprise.

Infrastructure Development

In **2017**, CPA dredged the channel going to CIP and in **December 2023**, OPASCOR continued the dredging on the navigational area going to CIP.

OPASCOR dredging project will be completed in the 3rd quarter of 2024. The new draft will be **12 meters**.





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Infrastructure Development

In **2018**, OPASCOR built a *1-hectare Finger Pier facility* on the north side dedicated for general cargoes. It started operating in **October 2019**.

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

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Equipment Modernization

■ In **2012**, OPASCOR started its equipment modernization program by acquiring its first set of Brand New Heavy Equipment composed of 1 Unit Gantry Crane and 2 Units RTGs.



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Equipment Modernization

Now, we have 5 Quay Cranes and 16 RTGs.

■ We have coming 1 QC and 2 RTGs arriving in mid-April 2024.

In 2008, OPASCOR built a Bulk Handling facility otherwise known as the Cebu Bulk Grain Terminal (CBGT). The facility is located within the CIP and a joint project between the Cebu Port Authority and OPASCOR. It began its commercial operations in 2010. The facility primarily handles wheat, soya meal, soya beans, corn and other bulk grain cargoes.

Improving workflows and optimizing processes minimize idle time and maximize service throughput.








