A Strategic Milestone

20 + 10 Years

Operational rights starting October 2027

New Concessions: Cabinda & Soyo Terminals

Expanding Angola's Maritime Reach

Cabinda Terminal

Strategic multi-purpose concession for general cargo. Key for the region's economic development, facilitating trade between neighbouring countries.

Soyo Terminal

Long-term concession focused on oil & gas logistics, with plans for future general cargo expansion. Positions Soyo as a critical hub for the Zaire Province and cross-border trade.

Investment & Modernization

Commitment to significant investment in infrastructure, including new quays, modern handling equipment, and enhanced storage to boost operational efficiency and capacity.

Luanda Terminal (Boavista)

General Information

- 20 years + 5 years concession since 2007
- 426 personnel + 625 third-party workers
- Storage capacity: 12,000 TEUs
- 480 reefer plugs in racks + 250 additional
- Main berth: 370m length, 10.5-11.5m draft
- 3 x MHC800, 3 x MHC550, 2 x MHC500 cranes

Luanda Terminal Development



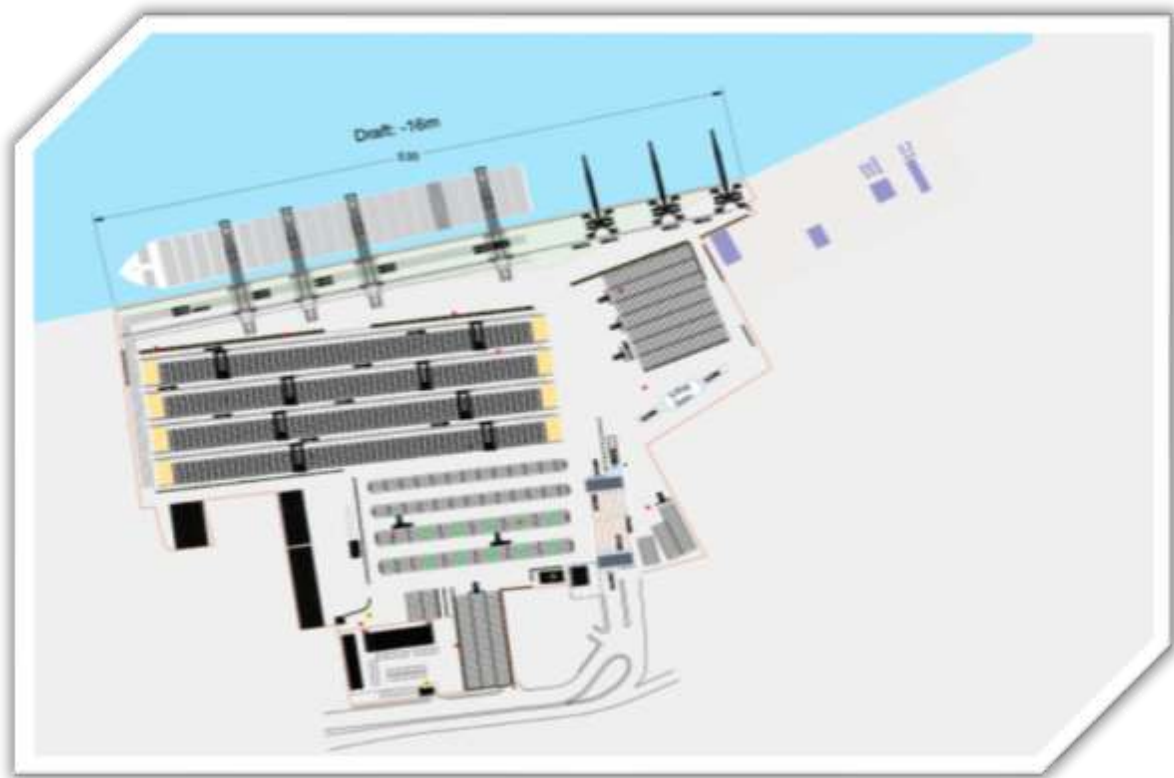
Current: Second Quay

Extension to 350m + 22m for vessel wires. Draft 12.5-13m on high water. Final works awaiting authorities' confirmation.



Long-term: Major Expansion

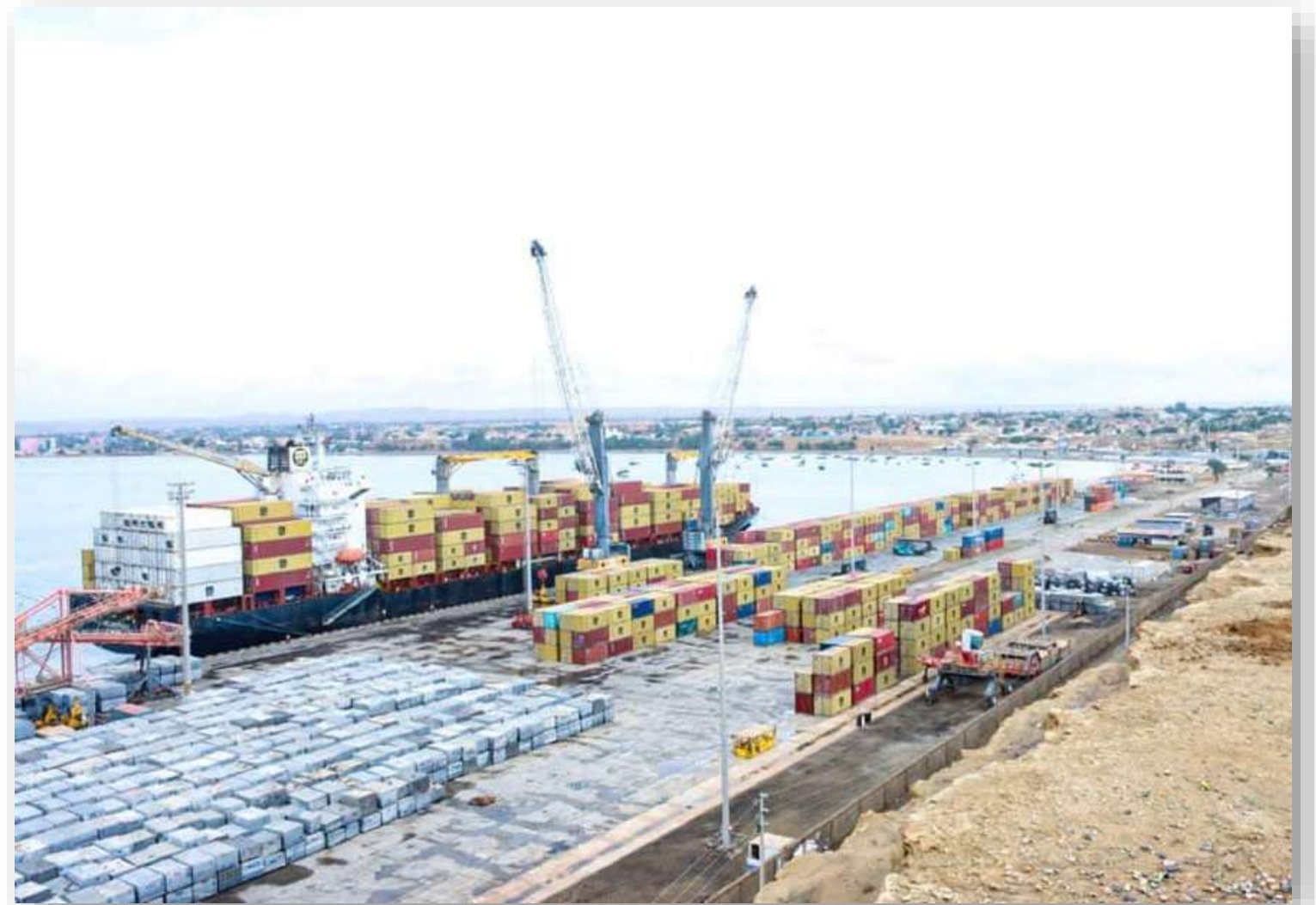
Quay length: 535m straight. Draft: 16m alongside. Max 5 ship-to-shore cranes (24 rows, 70m outreach). Min 4 MHC Liebherr 550-800 (100 tons lifting).



Namibe Terminal

General Information

- 20 years + 5 years concession since May 2014
- Quay length: 754m
- Yard space: 12.5 hectares
- Employees: 256 + 156 third-party workers
- 2 Mobile cranes MHC-550
- 80 reefer plugs
- Draft: 10.5m

Built by Sogester, providing education to children in the Dande Municipality.



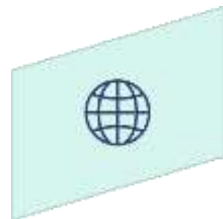

Constructing new facilities, providing food, and education for 87 children in Cacuaco.



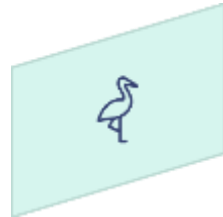
